Upon receipt of the original Writ of Attachment or Execution, we will run the vehicle to confirm ownership and to assure that the title is in the exact name as on the Writ of Attachment or Execution.

ESTIMATED costs associated with the seizure and sale:

Cost of Seizure

\$400.00 (INCLUDES RESEARCH, ATTEMPTS)

Towing

\$125.00 3 Miles minimum (average amount for vehicle-depends on what is being seized)

Storage

\$280.00 - IF 14 DAYS (@ \$20 PER DAY)

\$600.00 - IF 30 DAYS (OR REDUCED MONTHLY RATE)

Necessary Expense if unable to seize Motor Vehicle \$50.00 (pending attempts)

If the defendant files bankruptcy, your client would be responsible for Sheriff's and storage fees.

Please initial the following to confirm that you agree with the terms of the Writ of Attachment/Exeuction of the vehicle.
